

Calvary Scrip Corner: The holidays are coming! Are you ready? If you are not aware, Calvary sells gift cards every Sunday between services to offset church debts. We purchase them at a discount and sell them at face value. The discount ranges from 1.5%-16% depending on the retailer.

Remember those small gifts for teachers, mail carriers, etc. and if your office distributes gift cards at holiday gatherings. We carry an inventory of area grocery, gas, home improvement, restaurant, and retail stores. We also can order a large variety from our vendor. You will need to order cards by December 9th to guarantee delivery in time for Christmas. A list of participating retailers is available at the Scrip table in the narthex.

If you prefer high tech, you can set up purchasing e-scrip cards that benefit Calvary from your smart phone. You can even purchase them for airline tickets! Advent – A Time to Be Still

(Reflections on God's Greatest Story)

Every day, pick one of the following to really delve into the scripture. This is a great way to go a little further on your journey.

A.) Begin by quieting yourself in God's presence. Read through the scripture and journal anything and everything that the Holy Spirit brings to your mind. Lookup words or phrases that you are unsure of. What might today's reading be revealing to you about this season? You? Your family?

- B.) Begin by quieting yourself in God's presence. Invite the Holy Spirit to guide and direct your attention and imagination as you encounter the story of the birth of Jesus from the gospel of Luke. Praying scripture with imagination allows the Spirit to guide us into places of insight about ourselves and God. Slowly read the daily scripture to become more familiar with the plot, the characters, and the landscape. Begin to imagine the scene. What's happening? Imagine yourself in the scene. Who are you? What character do you portray? What do you see? What do you hear? Smell? Feel? Who else is there? What do they look like? What's the mood of the scene? Invite and trust the Spirit to guide you as you watch the movie play in your mind. Let go of any desire for historical accuracy, and actively enter the text. Watch what the characters do. Listen to what they say. What do you say? Engage in conversation with the characters in the text. Don't worry about making things up. Trust the Spirit to speak and reveal God's truth to you as you pray. Prayerfully reflect on what you experienced in the text. What does God want you to know? How does this experience of prayer draw you closer to Jesus?
- C.) Sit comfortably. Release noise and distractions and chaos. Let go of everything that keeps you from being fully present to God right in this moment. Invite the Holy Spirit to open your ears to hear the Living Word. Pray for the Holy Spirit to reveal something anew to you today. Read silently or aloud through the scripture the first time VERY SLOWLY. Look for a word or a phrase that catches your attention. When you see that word or phrase, pause and just sit with it for a while. Read silently or aloud through the same scripture a second time VERY SLOWLY. Listen now for how that word or phrase connects with your life. What is God saying to you in his word?
