



Book Studies: New Year, New Studies, New You!



We have changed the format of our Sunday school!

Effective January 13, 2019, we will offer a combined 3 year-old and 4 year-old preschool class headed up by Ms. Shelley. Preschool students will go directly to the classroom at 9:20 a.m.
