For Youth finishing 8<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>

Our purpose is twofold: 1) building relationships with a community in need, while pointing to the love of Jesus Christ, and 2) providing a place and opportunity for our youth (and their leaders) to strengthen their faith while building relationships and serving as the hands and feet of Jesus. We provide this opportunity by reaching out to homeowners who are financially struggling, elderly or disabled, and who own a home in need of repair, no matter the reason. The work sites are in the community surrounding Camp Harmison, Berkeley Springs, WV. They include Hancock, MD; Warfordsburg, PA; and Berkeley Springs, Great Cacapon and Paw Paw, WV.

This is an opportunity for youth to not only build relationships and experience serving as the hands and feet of Jesus in a real-world situation, but also to learn new skills. The work will include paint prep and painting, caulking, deck repairs, door and window repairs and replacement, yard clean-up, building decks and handicap ramps, etc. In this mission field, the youth do the work, the leaders provide the supervision, support, and how-to expertise.

We will be tent camping during the week, so the youth will need to bring sleeping bags and air mattresses if they desire. Meals will be as follows, breakfast each day will be provided by the camp, we will have bagged lunches to take with us to the worksites, and each night other than Friday will be provided by a local church. Friday night will be our night out to eat, dinner will be covered by the youth mission fund. Wednesday afternoon we will have a break from our worksites to go swimming in a local lake, there is a snack bar at the lake if the youth desire to be able to grab food they will need to bring their own money.
